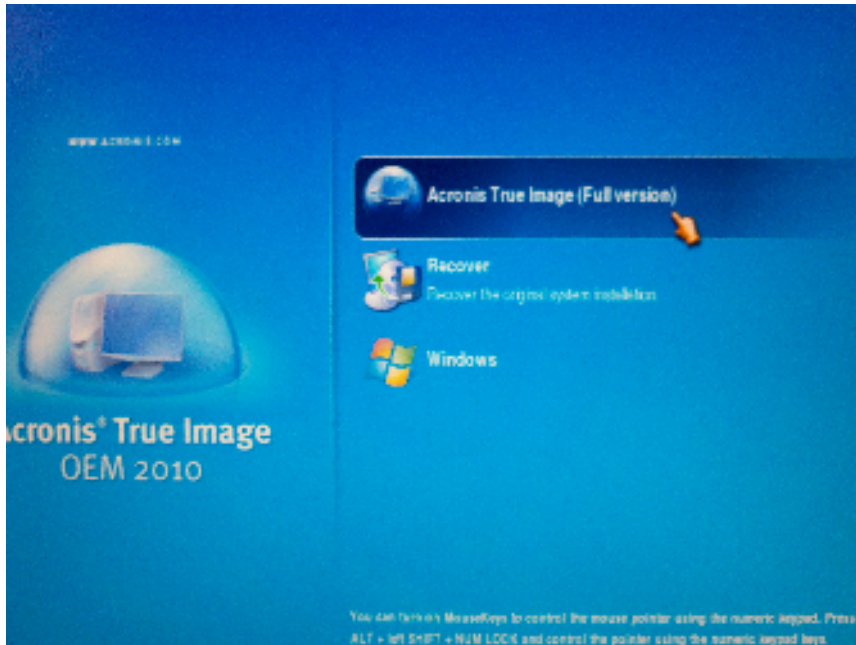
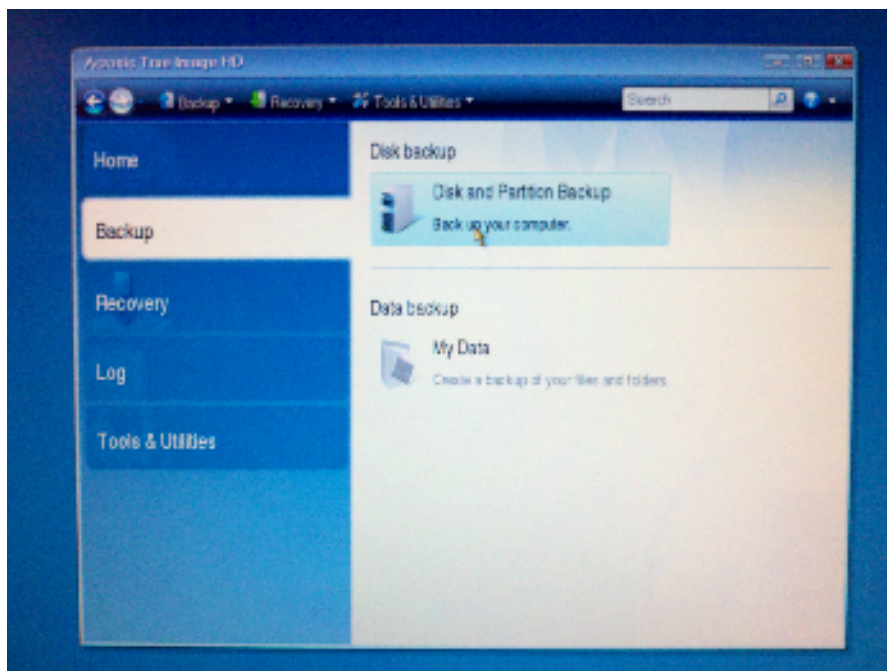


Creating a new Acronis Backup

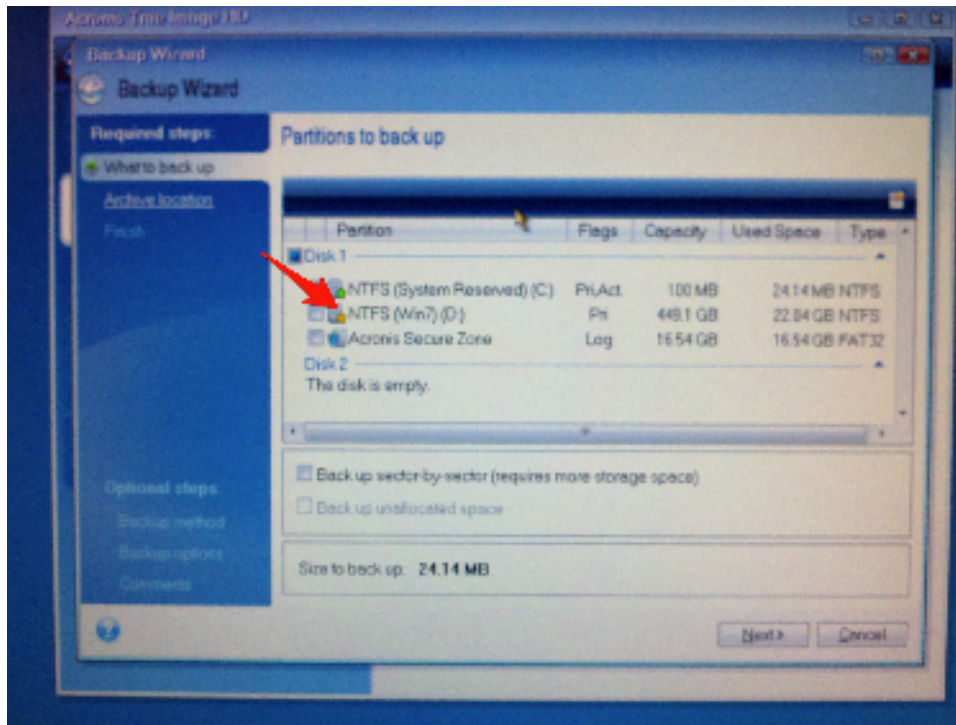
1. Press F11 while the computer is booting to enter the Acronis utility. If you receive a message about “Linux command line utility”, cancel that window.
2. Click on Acronis True Image (Full Version)



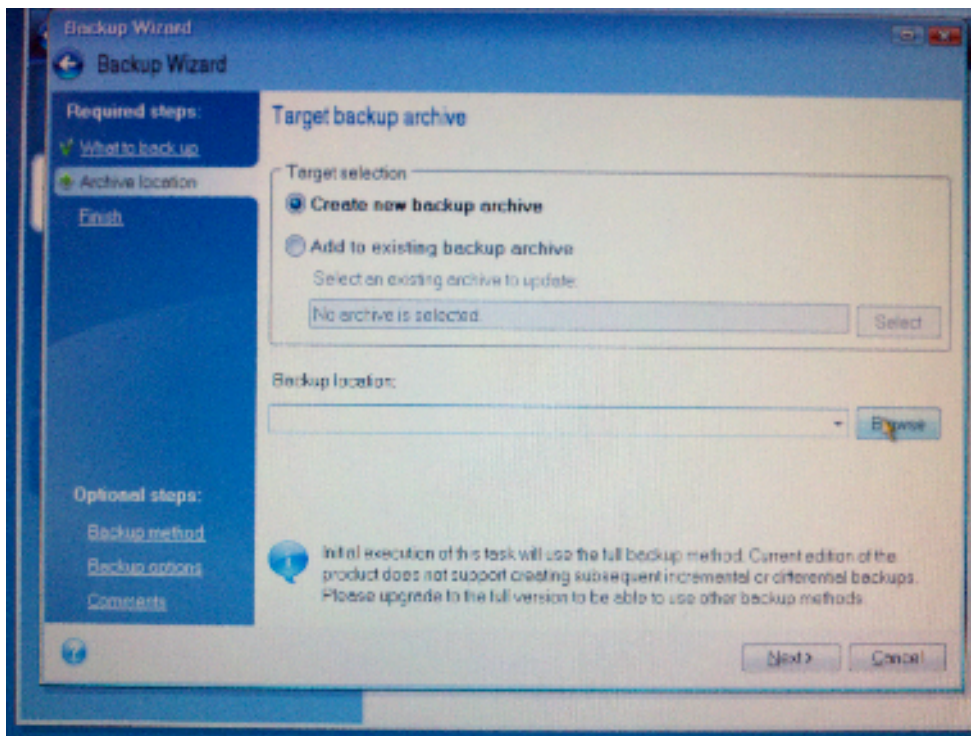
3. Choose “Disk Partition and Backup”



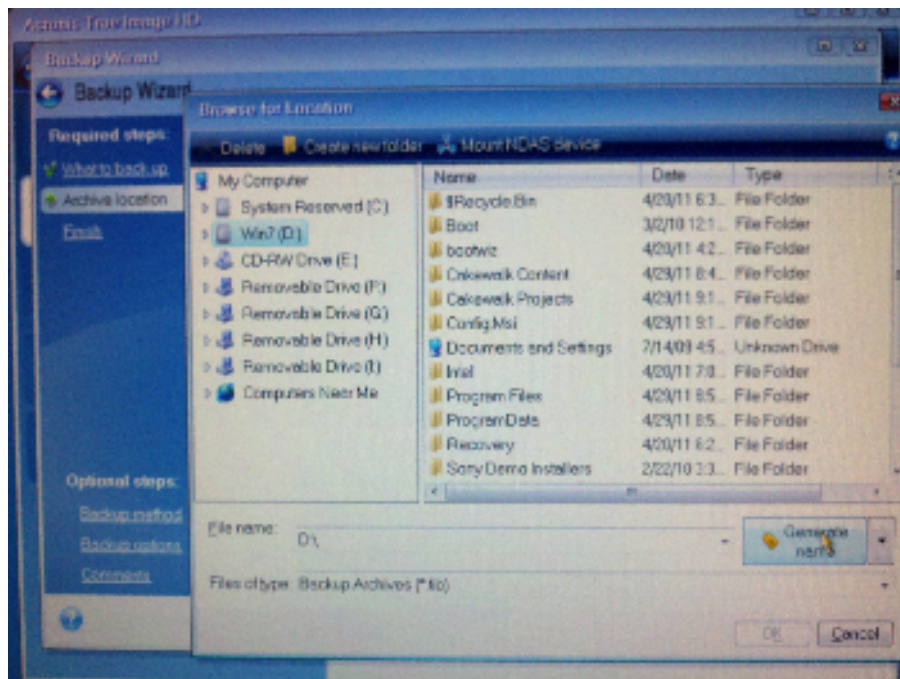
4. Select the drive you want to backup. You will want to choose your Windows C:\ drive, not the “system reserved” drive.



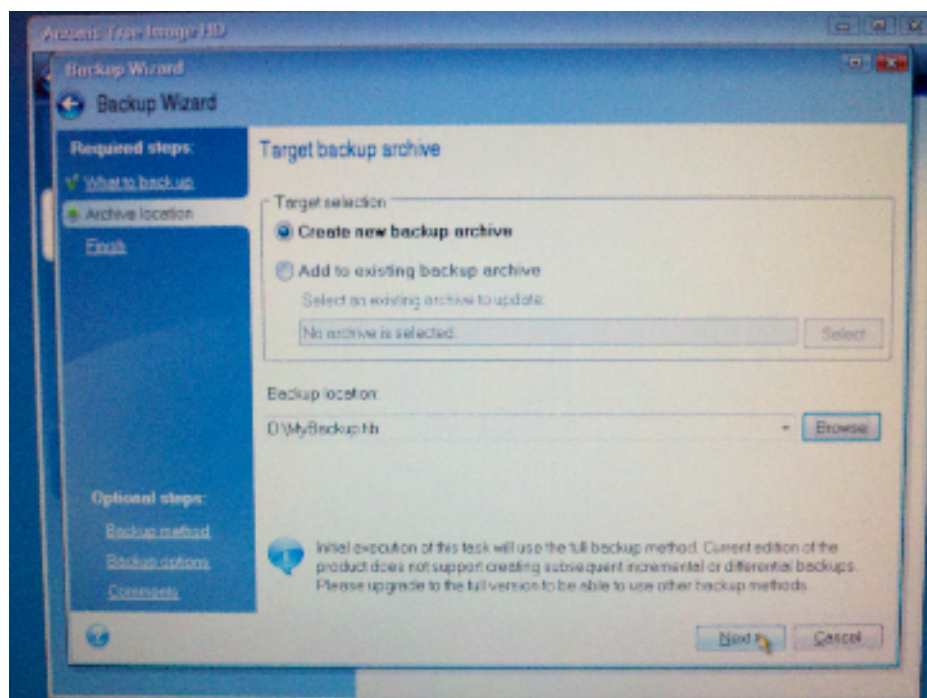
5. Choose “Create New Backup Archive”, then click on Browse.



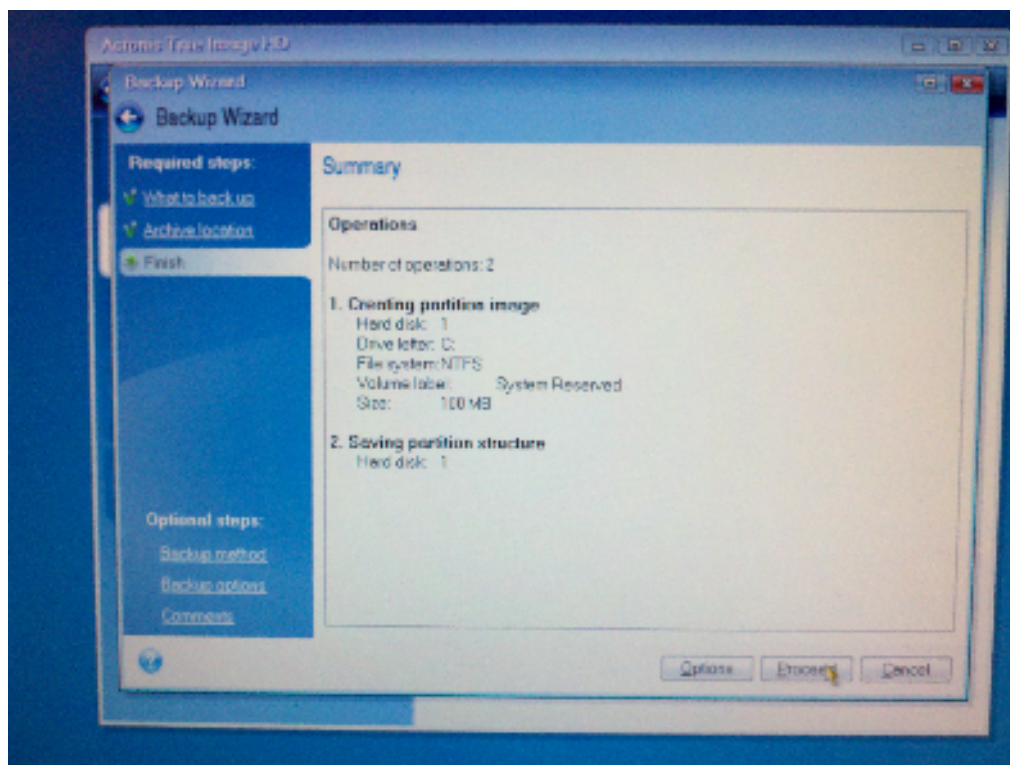
- Click on “Generate Name” to automatically create a name for your new backup, alternative you can name it whatever you choose by typing it into the area to the left of the “Generate Name” button. Also choose the drive that you want to back up **TO**. We recommend backing it up to a drive other than the C: drive. This can be an extra internal drive, or an external drive that you have connected to the computer. Then click OK and you will be returned to the previous menu.



- Click the Next button



8. Confirm your settings then click on “Proceed”



9. Acronis will now start the backup process. You will receive a confirmation screen when it is complete. Close the Acronis program to reboot the computer back into Windows.
