

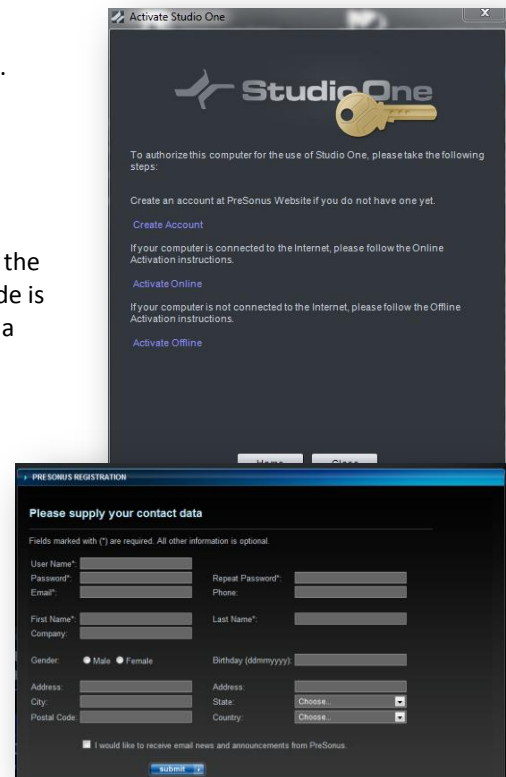
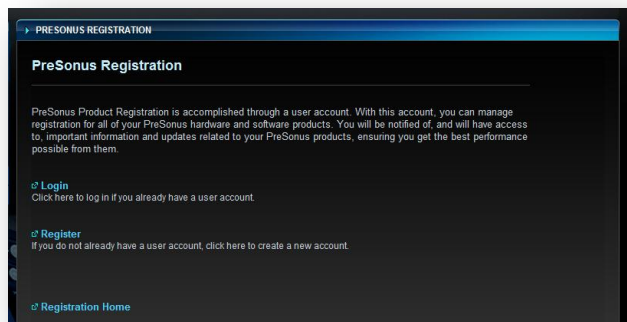
How to Download and Activate Studio One

Your electronic download-only version of Studio One will be installed from a downloaded installer package. Once installed, Studio One must be activated in order to use the program. The following outlines the required steps to download, install, and activate Studio One.

Step 1: Create a User Account

If you are a new Studio One user, you will need to create a user account. Follow the Create Account link if your computer is connected to the Internet. If your computer is not connected to the Internet, go to a computer that is connected to the internet and visit this URL: <http://www.presonus.com/registration>.

Once at the registration page, click on the Register link, and then fill out the form and click on Submit. Please be certain the email address you provide is correct, and that email from PreSonus will not be filtered or deleted by a SPAM filter or other software.



An email from PreSonus Registration will now be automatically sent to the email address you provided in order to verify your email address. Click on the link in this email to activate your account. If you do not see the email within a few minutes of clicking on Submit, then it likely ended up in a spam folder, or was deleted automatically by your email client. In this case, please contact techsupport@presonus.com to have you account manually activated.

Step 2: Register, Download, and Install Studio One

Now that you have created and activated your user account, you can register and download your copy of Studio One. Login to your account, then click on Software Registration and enter your Studio One Product Key, then click on Submit. You will then see a list of many download links, and a Software List link. Click on the Software List link and you will then see your copy of Studio One listed with download links below. Click on the appropriate Studio One installer download link for your OS to download the Studio One installer.

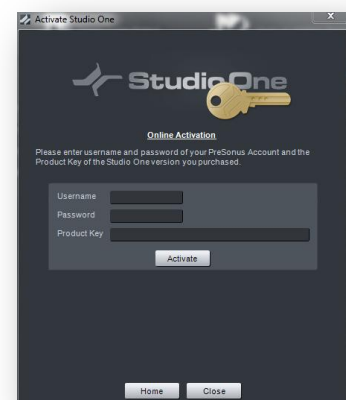
Once downloaded, run the installer and follow the on-screen instructions to install Studio One.

Step 3: Activate Studio One

After installation, launch Studio One and the Activate Studio One menu will appear.

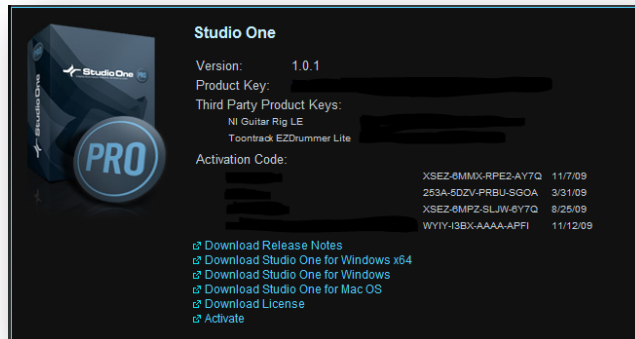
Online Activation

If the computer on which Studio One has been installed is connected to the Internet, click on the Activate Online link and enter your previously created account Username, Password, and the Product Key you received with the Studio One installation disc, or in an email if you made a purchase online. Click on the Activate button to finish the activation process.

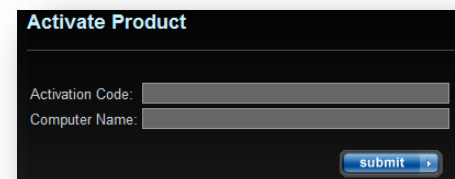


Offline Activation

If the computer on which Studio One has been installed is not connected to the Internet, click on the Activate Offline link in the Activate Studio One menu, and make note of the Activation Code shown under step 3 in the instructions. Then, go to a computer with an internet connection, visit <http://www.presonus.com/registration> and log in to your account. Click on Software Registration link and enter your Product Key as printed on the Studio One package, or provided via email. Click on Submit and you will then be taken to your Software List, which should now have your Studio One product listed.



Next, click on the Activate link listed next to your Studio One product and enter the Activation Code as given in the Offline Activation menu. You may list a computer name to help you keep track of your 5 allowed activations; for instance, if you intend to install Studio One on a desktop and laptop, you may choose to name the activations "DESKTOP" and "LAPTOP".



You will then be given a link to download your User License file. Save this file to some external media (CD, thumb drive, etc), and then copy the file to the computer on which Studio One is installed. Finally, you may either locate the file in the Offline Activation menu, or simply drag and drop the file on top of the menu to activate Studio One.

How to Install the Included Loops and Instruments

Studio One comes with many audio loops and instruments that are organized into 'Sound Sets', as well as demo songs and tutorial videos. The number of Soundsets available to install will depend on the version of Studio One you have installed (Artist or Pro).

You will need to download the Soundsets in order to install them, as this is an electronic download-only version of Studio One. To do so, log in to your user account and go to the My Software page. Click on any of the Soundset download links to download it. To install, place the Soundset file in the desired location on your computer, then simply drag the Soundset file onto the Start Page of Studio One.

How to install the Demos and Tutorials

First, download the Demos and Tutorials zip file from your user account, then follow these steps:

1. Extract the complete Demos and Tutorials.zip file.
2. Start Studio One and open the Studio One/Studio One Installation menu.
3. In the Studio One installation menu:
 - a. Select the Studio One Demos and Tutorials check box
 - b. Select your extracted Studio One DVD1 folder from the zip file at the Install from selector
4. Now click **Install 1 Packet** to install the Demos and Tutorials
5. Press **Done** when the installation is finished.

How to Install the Included Third-Party Content

We have partnered with third-party software manufacturers Toontrack and Native Instruments to bring you some very cool instruments and effects. Installing and activating these instruments and effects can be a bit of chore, but it's well worth it.

Installation

Downloading and installing the third-party software is relatively simple. Log in to your user account and go to My Software. Notice that at the top of your software listing there are serial numbers listed for Toontrack EZDrummer Lite and Native Instruments Guitar Rig LE - this will become important after installation when you need to authorize these plug-ins.

Download the zip file for the version of EZDrummer Lite, Kore Player (and PreSonus Vol 1 Kore Sounds if you have Studio One Pro), and Guitar Rig LE that corresponds to your OS. Then extract the zip files and run the installer package for each to install. Be sure to follow all instructions carefully within these third-party installers.

After installation has been completed for each plug-in, restart Studio One so that it can scan for and find each plug-in. You will need to authorize each plug-in the first time you use them.

Authorization

Toontrack EZDrummer:

To authorize EZDrummer, load the instrument on the Song page (drag and drop it from the Instruments Browser onto the arrangement), and then use the built-in authorization interface. Your serial number is listed in your user account under your Studio One software listing as pointed out before. You will need to visit the Toontrack website at http://www.toontrack.com/new_user.asp and create a user account. Then register your serial number in that account and copy and paste an authorization code into EZDrummer to authorize it.

Native Instruments Guitar Rig LE and Kore Player:

The NI Service Center is installed with these plug-ins, which you will use to authorize them. This should open automatically the first time you open either plug-in, but can also be launched as a standalone application. You will need to create an NI user account if you do not already have one, and then enter the serial numbers for each plug-in. Your Guitar Rig LE serial is listed in the Studio One Installation menu as shown above.
